- **ST ROSE CHOIR** - SATB choir open to men, women & teens (grades 9+). The choir sings at weekend liturgies, rotating between the 4:30, 8:00 & 10:00 from September-May. The choir sings a variety of styles: classical, traditional, contemporary, gospel, etc. Rehearsals are Tuesdays, 7:30PM in church.
- **CONTEMPORARY CHOIR** - open to men, women & teens (grades 9+), singers and instrumentalists. The Contemporary Choir sings contemporary compositions at weekend liturgies, rotating between the 4:30, 8:00 & 10:00 from September - May. Rehearsals are Sunday evenings at 6:45 PM in church.
- **FUNERAL SCHOLA** - open to anyone available to sing at funerals. A very flexible group, you can sing as often, or as little, as your schedule permits. Rehearsals are the 2nd Monday of each month, September - May at 8:45 AM and 1/2 hour before funerals.
- **CHILDREN'S CHOIR** - open to boys and girls of the parish, grades 2-8. The choir usually sings at 10:00 liturgy once a month from September - April; the Children's Choir also sings at special liturgies throughout the year. Rehearsals are Monday evenings at 6:00 PM in church.
- **TEEN MUSICIANS**— Newly formed Teen Choir open to high school aged singers & instrumentalists, 6 rehearsals during the year and 3 Liturgies.
- **ADULT BELL CHOIR** - We are looking for experienced musicians & /or experienced bell ringers.  
*The bell choir plays at a variety of liturgies throughout the year.  
Rehearsals are Thursday evenings at 7:15 PM in church.*
- **MULTI-AGED BELL CHOIR** - open to adults & youth - grades 7 and older that have musical background, (background in ringing bells not necessary). The choir plays at a variety of liturgies.  
*Rehearsals are Thursday evenings at 5:45 PM in church.*
- **YOUTH HANDBELL CHOIR** -  
*Open to youth of the parish, grades 5 and older who would like to learn to play handbells, rehearsals begin in September, Mondays at 5:00 PM in church. No audition required.*
- **INSTRUMENTALIST** - *If you have played an instrument for at least 5 years, we are interested. You can play as often, or as little, as you desire. Any and all instruments welcome.*
- **KEYBOARD** - *Open to experienced keyboard players who are interested in volunteering to play the electronic, digital keyboard at weekend liturgies along with our organist. You can play as often, or as little as your schedule permits.*
- **DANCERS** – *For our mid winter music ministry production.*

# LITURGICAL MINISTRIES

- **Art & Environment** team volunteers work throughout the liturgical year to create environments that enhance the inspiration and worship of our parish community. The biggest need involves the set up and take down of seasonal decorations. Also needed are individuals who can assist with planning, artwork, sewing, carpentry, and technical support, as well as maintenance of floral displays and ongoing plant care. It is not necessary to participate at all times, but according to interest and availability. - **Altar Server** 5<sup>th</sup> grade or older for Sunday and weekday liturgies and weddings; training will be provided.
- **Adult Server for Daily Mass** assist at the daily 8:00AM Mass; training provided.
- **Adult Server for Funerals** - Men & women, available mornings; training will be provided;
- **Cross Bearer** - lead the procession, men, women and teens.
- **Greeters** - Greeting fellow parishioners at a weekend Mass is not only an important ministry, but also an enjoyable and quite rewarding one. The job of greeters is to welcome people as they enter church, hand them a liturgy guide, and make them feel as if their presence at Mass is important and desired. Greeters usually arrive about 30 minutes before the start of Mass, station themselves at their assigned door, and begin greeting people. Greeters are assigned about two times per month, although this can vary depending on circumstances.
- **Eucharist Ministers** distribute Eucharist at weekend and special liturgies. You will be participating in the handing on of what has been given to you - namely the life and love of Christ present in the Eucharist, and handing on to others the healing, love, and nourishment that you yourself have received through the Body and Blood of Christ.
