THE MASS IS CHANGING!

Actually, the WORDS of the Mass are changing, not the Mass itself. All the parts of the Mass will be in their familiar places. What is changing is what we SAY and what we SING.

The New Roman Missal will be used starting with the weekend of the First Sunday of Advent, November 26-27, 2011. We are preparing a number of opportunities to help Saint Rose of Lima parishioners be ready for this change.

- **First, Bulletin Inserts.** A series of 11 bulletin inserts will begin on September 10-11 and continue through November 20-21. These inserts will also be on the website on the bulletin page.
- **Second, Information Sessions.** A series of four one-hour sessions will be held in church on the **Wednesdays of October**.
11am for those available during the day.
6pm for those who can come in the evening. (Religious Education classes are in the school at 6pm.)
- **Third, Children.** Children in School and Religious Education will be learning about these changes in their religion classes.
- **Fourth, Other News.** Information about materials to be used in church will be in the weekly bulletins. New music for the “Glory to God,” “Holy, Holy,” “Acclamation,” “Amen,” and other revised texts of the Mass will be practiced in Church before Masses as we get closer to the start date.
